1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Nordic Folkboat Gold Cup Statutes and the Nordic Folkboat International Class Rules 2017-2020 will apply. The current versions can be found on www.folkboat.com.
- 1.3 No national authority prescriptions will apply, except what prescribes in NoR 1.4 (b) and 3.3.
- 1.4 Racing rules will be changed,
 - (a) RRS 35, A4 and A5 so that a boat failing to finish within 60 minutes after the first boat sailed the course and finished will be scored Did Not Finish, without a hearing;
 - (b) RRS 40 so that a competitor afloat shall wear personal flotation device;
 - (c) RRS 44.1 so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty;
 - (d) RRS 60.1(a) so that a boat cannot protest another boat or competitor for a breach of a rule addressed in NoR 11.2;
 - (e) RRS 61.1(b) so that information about protests from race committee, technical committee or protest committee will be displayed on the official notice board;
 - (f) RRS 62.2 and 66 to shorten the time limit for a request for redress and for reopening of protest hearings on the last scheduled day of racing;
 - (g) RRS A4 and A5 so that a boat starting later than 10 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start, without a hearing.

The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules. All changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

- 1.5 The official language in the regatta documents is English. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence, except in the case of the Gold Cup Statutes, for which the Danish text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may, according to World Sailing Regulation 20, be required to display advertisements chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Nordic Folkboat class, having a valid Nordic Folkboat measurement certificate according to class rule 1.70. The certificate shall be presented to the organizing authority no later than at registration.
- 3.2 Every competitor shall be a valid member of a yacht club under a national authority. The competitor that is in charge on board shall also be a valid member of the yacht club he or she represents in the regatta and be a valid member of a National Nordic Folkboat Association under Nordic Folkboat International Association (NFIA).
- 3.3 The competitor that is in charge on board shall follow the Swedish Sailing Federation's license rules for competitor. This rule applies from the year the competitor reaches the age of 13. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this rule.

4 ENTRY AND FEES

- 4.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form as directed on www.sailosterlen.se and paying the entry fee online as described during the entry process **no later than June 20, 2018**.
- 4.2 The entry fee per boat is **SEK 3 000**.
- 4.3 Late entry, accompanied by an extra fee of SEK 1 500, may be accepted at the discretion of the organizing authority no later than July 1, 2018.
- 4.4 The entry fee includes
- Boat lift fees
 - Mooring fees during the regatta
 - Tickets for the crew to
 - Breakfast with opportunity to make lunch packet (5 days)
 - Opening Ceremony Buffet, July 8
 - Closing Ceremony Dinner, July 13
- 4.5 Additional options to book
- Tickets to After Sail including meal of the day à SEK 100
 - Extra tickets to Breakfast à SEK 50
 - Extra tickets to Opening Ceremony Buffet à SEK 200
 - Extra tickets to Closing Ceremony Dinner à SEK 300
- 4.6 A boat cannot be registered before the entry fee is paid in full. No entry is complete until it has been accepted by the organizing authority. The organizing authority is not responsible for any costs incurred by the non-acceptance of a boat's registration.

5.2 Schedule may be changed. Changes will be displayed on the official notice board as described in the sailing instructions.

6 REGISTRATION AND INSPECTIONS

6.1 Participating boats shall be registered at the Race Office located in Seglarpaviljongen, Simrishamn Marina, Sunday July 8 at 08:00–18:00. Each boat shall be available for inspections, boat participated in the Swedish Championship Nordic Folkboat 2018 no later than at 17:00 and other boats no later than at 14:00.

6.2 The following documents shall be presented at latest at registration.

- (a) Valid measurement certificate.
- (b) Documents indicating valid memberships and license according to NoR 3.2 and 3.3.
- (c) A complete crew list with name, contact information, club and nationality, including name and phone number of contact person, for each crew member.
- (d) Contact phone number ashore during the regatta.

7 CREW AND EQUIPMENT

7.1 A crew member may not be changed without prior written permission of the race committee.

7.2 Damaged or lost equipment may not be replaced without prior written permission of the race committee. Requests for replacement shall be made to the race committee at the earliest opportunity.

7.3 A boat or equipment may for compliance with the rules be inspected at any time. On the water, the race committee or the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.

7.4 In accordance with RRS G3, a boat borrowed or chartered for the regatta may use the sail number and national letters of the boat and club it is representing in the regatta.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1 The sailing instructions will be handed out upon completion of the registration and be available on www.sailosterlen.se from Sunday July 8 at 18:00.

9 VENUE

9.1 The venue will be Simrishamn Marina and on the water east from Simrishamn.

10 THE COURSE

10.1 Windward-leeward course with an offset mark at the windward mark and a leeward gate will be sailed. The minimum distance between the windward mark and the leeward gate will, according to the Gold Cup Statutes, be 1,8 nautical miles.

11 PENALTIES

11.1 RRS 44.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11.2 The penalty for a breach of NoR 1.4(b), 2, 13, 14 or 15 may be less than disqualification if the protest committee so decides.

12 SCORING

12.1 7 races are scheduled. 4 races are required to be completed to constitute a series for the Gold Cup trophy to be awarded.

12.2 Excluding scores

(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

13.1 Participating boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta without written permission of the race committee.

14 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

14.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around the boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta, except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION

15.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make wireless transmissions while racing nor receive wireless communications not available to all boats, except communication restricted solely internal at the boat. This restriction also applies to smartphones, mobile telephones or any device connected to the Internet.

15.2 The race committee may broadcast information to the competitors by VHF (regarding for example postponements, restarts, intentions of the race committee etc.). Channel will be announced in the sailing instructions or on the notice board.

16 TROPHY AND PRIZES

16.1 The Nordic Folkboat Gold Cup trophy, the Senator Hagelstein Memory Prize, will in accordance with the Gold Cup Statutes be awarded the yacht club that winning boat is representing.

16.2 The organizer's prizes will be given.

17 MEDIA ETC.

- 17.1 By entering the regatta the competitors allow the organizing authority to process the given information by ADP and to free use and publish the given information, the results and images of the competitors, on the Internet, in media and for press information or similar purpose.

18 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 18.1 The competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

19 INSURANCE

- 19.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. The organizing authority cannot be held responsible for any issues arising as a result of actions or omissions by a competitor or a participating boat, including insufficient insurance cover.
